

Canada-US Marine Ecosystems Scholarship

The Canadian Studies Center, Henry M. Jackson School of International Studies is offering four \$200 scholarships to students who submit papers to the 2009 Fisheries and Marine Ecosystems Conference (FAME). Eligible papers must address cross-border or Canadian issues such as Canada-U.S. marine management and policy making (collaborative management or best practices); current issues facing local marine and coastal ecosystems in Canada and the U.S.; or proposals/papers that seek to further collaborative research between the two countries. Proposals must accompany paper submissions to the conference. Students who are selected will be provided with a \$200 scholarship and invited to join the Affiliated Graduate Professional Development Program with the Canadian Studies Center. Awardees will also be listed on the Center website and in the Spring 2009 Center Report.

Eligibility

Students must be enrolled at one of the University of Washington campuses and be a US citizen or permanent resident. Paper/research presentations at the conference must include the focus mentioned in the application.
