FULBRIGHT GRANTS TO CANADA

2010 - 2011

Approximately **20 Fulbright Full Grants** in all fields of study relevant to Canada or U.S.-Canada relations will provide round-trip international transportation, maintenance for one academic year, and health and accident insurance.

Candidates may either enroll in a graduate degree program at a Canadian university, or undertake one year of research or instruction in Canada as part of a graduate degree at their American university.

Graduating seniors are encouraged to apply to begin their graduate work in Canada.

One **Fulbright-Cassandra Pyle Award** is available for doctoral study at a university in any field of study relevant to international education.

One **Fulbright-Oishei Award** will also be available to applicants permanently residing in the greater Buffalo, NY area or studying in Buffalo for graduate study or research in business, healthcare, education and cultural, social and civic needs.

Specific eligibility requirements, information on benefits, etc. may be accessed on IIE's Web site at www.us.fulbrightonline.org. Fulbright Program Advisers (FPAs) establish the campus deadline for receipt of enrolled student applications; "At-Large" students must submit their completed applications to the U.S. Student Programs Division at IIE headquarters in New York by October 19, 2009.
